**BRIEF STATEMENT ABOUT THE JOB:**\* Prepare, pour, smooth and finish cement for slabs, walls, floors and various outside work such as sidewalks, curbs, catch basins, etc., to specific textures. Spread concrete to specified depth and workable consistencies. Insure concrete is floated properly and surfaces are smooth, level and finished as specified as with a pebble stone topping, marble chips, etc. Mold expansion joints and edges, using edging tools, jointers and straightedge. Finish vertical surfaces by removing rough or defective spots and patching with fresh concrete or by wetting concrete and rubbing with abrasive stone. Lay up brick and concrete block as specified. Repair, replace and repoint stone, structural tile, glass blocks and ceramic tile. Reset and replace stone coping and marble trim. Apply mortar and point up brick, stone and tile on various buildings, walls, foundations, etc., and clean as required. Mix mortar or direct mixing as per formula. Work from drawings, specifications and job layouts. Operate University vehicles as required. **JOB REQUIREMENTS:** Requires the use of shop mathematics together with the use of complicated drawings, specifications, charts, tables, various types of adjustable measuring instruments and the training generally applicable in a particular or specialized occupation; the equivalent to 1 to 3 years applied trades training; plus over 1 year up to and including 2 years of effective experience.
