**BRIEF STATEMENT ABOUT THE JOB:**\* Clean, adjust and perform maintenance on oil and gas burners; clean and service oil-burning and gas-fired incinerators, low- and high-pressure boilers, and flues by replacing oil filters, blower belts, air filters, etc. Perform repairs to a variety of mechanical and simple control components of heating equipment, such as oil and circulating pumps and oil and gas burners. Insure all safety valves, cutouts, electric eyes, visual and audible alarms, and all safety features of units are working properly. Restart oil and gas burners and boilers as necessary and make minor repairs to mechanical systems and piping associated with boilers. Operate various tools such as pipe threader, voltage tester, hammer drill, boiler cleaning and rodding machine, etc. **JOB REQUIREMENTS:** Requires the use of commercial English, grammar and arithmetic such as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, including decimals and fractions; simple use of formulas, charts, tables, drawings, specifications, schedules, wiring diagrams, together with the use of adjustable measuring instruments, graduates and the like requiring interpretation in their various applications; or the posting, preparation, interpretation and checking of reports, forms, records and comparable data; plus over 1 year up to and including 2 years of effective experience.
